

OAS Partnerships for Education and Training in 2010:

1. **OAS/Structuralia Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and Structuralia of Spain awarded thirteen (13) scholarships for master's degrees in a variety of topics to be delivered online in Spanish. The scholarships cover 51% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$148,967.00 or an average of US\$11,459.00 per student.
2. **OAS/Instituto de Empresas Scholarship Program (Summer 2010).** The OAS and the Instituto de Empresas of Spain awarded nine (9) scholarships for master's degrees in fields including International Management, International Relations, International Law, Communications, Journalism and Environmental Change to be delivered onsite in Spanish and in English. The scholarships cover between 30% and 40% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$93,061.00 or an average of US\$10,340.00 per student.
3. **OAS/Instituto de Empresas Scholarship Program (Winter 2010).** The OAS and the Instituto de Empresas of Spain awarded an additional six (6) scholarships for master's degrees. The scholarships cover between 30% and 40% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$63,486.00 or an average of US\$10,581.00 per student.
4. **OAS/Regiomontana Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Regiomontana University of Mexico awarded eight (8) scholarships for master's degrees in fields including Organizational Development, Tourism, Business Administration and International Finance to be delivered online in Spanish. The scholarships cover 50% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$64,000.00 or an average of US\$8,000.00 per student.
5. **OAS/Qatar/Harvard Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Government of Qatar in cooperation with Harvard University's Kennedy School of Executive Management awarded four (4) scholarships for professional development courses in Nonprofit Management to be delivered online in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$5,200.00 or an average of US\$1,300.00 per student.
6. **OAS/Qatar/Cornell Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Government of Qatar in cooperation with Cornell University's eCornell awarded two (2) scholarships for professional development courses in the fields of Executive Leadership and Hospitality Management to be delivered online in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$5,689.00 or an average of US\$2844.50 per student.
7. **OAS/Oxford Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the University of Oxford awarded two (2) scholarships for a professional development course in the field of Political Economy to be delivered online in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$2,018.00 or an average value of US\$1,009.00 per student.
8. **OAS/Thailand Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Government of Thailand awarded one (1) scholarship for a professional development course in the field of Entrepreneurship and Trade to be delivered onsite in English. The scholarship covers airfare, room and board, tuition, local transportation and health insurance for an estimated total value of US\$7,500.00.
9. **OAS/Israel (MASHAV) Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Government of Israel awarded ten (10) scholarships for professional development courses in fields including Public Security, Economic Development, Water Resource Management and Integration of Marginalized Youth in Society to be delivered onsite in Spanish. The scholarship covers tuition, room and board, health insurance and cultural tours for an estimated total value of US\$20,150.00 or an average value of US\$2,015.00 per student.
10. **OAS/Virtual Educa Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and Virtual Educa, in cooperation with the Educational Portal of the Americas awarded 32 scholarships for a professional development course in the field of Virtual Learning Environments to be delivered online in Spanish. The scholarships covers 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$21,700.00 or an average value of US\$700.00 per student.

11. **OAS/CONICET Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Argentine Cooperation Fund for Academic Activities and Research awarded one (1) scholarship for long-term post-doctoral research and eight (8) scholarships for short-term research and training in various fields to be undertaken in Argentina. The scholarships provide monthly stipends for an estimated total value of US\$64,181.00 or an average value of US\$7,131.00 per student.
12. **OAS/China Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Government of China awarded six (6) scholarships for undergraduate and graduate level degree studies in various field to be undertaken in China in English. The scholarships cover the cost of tuition and university fees, basic materials, accomodation and provide a monthly living allowance for an estimated total value of US\$161,972.00 or an average value of US\$26,995.33 per student.
13. **OAS/CIESS Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Inter-American Center for Social Security Studies of Mexico awarded four (4) scholarships for master's degrees in the field of Social Security Management to be delivered through blended learning (onsite & online) in Spanish. The scholarships cover 100% of tuition, sutdy materials and room and board during the onsite portion of the program for an estimated total value of US\$30,584.00 or an average value of US\$7,646.00 per student. The OAS contributed 50% of the value of this scholarship and CIESS contributed 50%.
14. **OAS/ITESM Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Monterrey Institute of Technology of Mexico awarded four (4) scholarships for master's degrees in the fields of Information Technology Administration and Adminitration and Finance to be delivered onsite in Spanish. The scholarships cover partial subsistence and 80% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$114,949.68 or an average value of US\$28,737.42 per student. The OAS contributed 21% of the value of this scholarship and ITESM contributed 79%.
15. **OAS/Harvard Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and Harvard University's Kennedy School of Executive Management awarded 20 scholarships for professional development courses in the fields of Nonprofit Administration and Change Leadership to be delivered online in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$26,000.00 or an average value of US\$13,000.00 per student. The OAS contributed 83% of the value of this scholarship and Harvard University contributed 17%.
16. **OAS/Cornell Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and Cornell University's eCornell awarded 20 scholarships for professional development certificate programs in the fields including Project Leadership, financial Management, Change Leadership and Hospitality Management to be delivered online in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$75,000.00 or an average value of US\$3,750.00 per student. The OAS contributed 53% of the value of this scholarship and Cornell University contributed 47%.
17. **OAS/OSHA Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Atlantic OSHA Training Center through the Metropolitan University of Puerto Rico (UMET) awarded 32 scholarships for a technical/vocational training course in the field of Occupational Safety and Health Standards for General Industry and Construction to be delivered onsite in English. The scholarships cover tuition, airfair, room and board and insurance for an estimated total value of US\$86,360.00 or an average value of US\$2,698.75 per student. The OAS contributed 54% of the value of this scholarship and OSHA contributed 46%.
18. **OAS/ITESM (Virtual) Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the Monterrey Institute of Technology's Virtual University awarded twelve (12) scholarships for master's degrees in the fields of Technology, Quality and Productivity, and Education to be delivered online in Spanish. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition for an estimated total value of US\$165,100.00 or an average value of US\$13,758.33 per student. The OAS contributed 50% of the value of this scholarship and ITESM contributed 50%.

19. **OAS/University for Peace Scholarship Program (2010).** The OAS and the University for Peace of Costa Rica awarded 17 scholarships for professional development courses in fields including Curriculum Design for Peace and Conflict Studies, Food Security, Disarmament, Environmental Security, Gender and Human Rights to be delivered onsite in English. The scholarships cover 100% of the cost of tuition and partial stipend for an estimated total value of US\$33,150.00 or an average value of US\$1,950.00 per student. The OAS contributed 60% of the value of this scholarship and the University for Peace contributed 40%.

In the majority of case, the students were also partners as most of the programs required some financial input from them”
